



Arts in AAPS

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AAPS 'Arts Advantage'

- 100% of AAPS elementary students receive 60 minutes of art and 60 minutes of music weekly.
- 60% of Middle School students are enrolled in visual art classes and 72% in music classes.
- 40% of AAPS High School students are enrolled in visual art and 57% in music classes.
- In 2015 AAPS BOE was awarded the Kennedy Center National School Board Award for school boards that support Arts programming, which came with a \$10,000 check for our Arts programs.
- AAPS performing arts groups regularly receive national and world distinctions



Percentage of with at least 1 suspension during the school year





Percentage with at least 1 suspension during the school year





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2016 SAT Mean Score









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

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



Ended June 30



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AAPS Foundation Grant Trend




