Overview

- Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT)
 - All 11th Grade Students Tested in Michigan
 - AAPS administered to 1,230 11th grade students April, 2016
 - Required by State of Michigan for Accountability
- Advantages of National Assessment (SAT)
- Provides valuable information about college readiness
- Nationally normed excellent comparative data
- Considered an important 'outcome' / 'exit' measure for PK-12 system
- Provides college entrance assessment free of charge for every student during the school day – important to ensure equity and opportunity



■New SAT 2016

- Redesigned to better reflect what students need to know to be ready for college
- Scored out of possible 400-1600 points
- 2016 Baseline data
- ■States that Test 100% of 11th grade Students:
 - Connecticut, Delaware, Michigan, New Hampshire
- ■Subjects Assessed for 11th Graders
 - Evidence-Based Reading & Writing
 - Mathematics












2016 SAT Total Mean Scores


Student Group Comparison




- ■What is College Readiness?
 - A student can enter a college classroom and successfully complete entry-level college requirements
 - Students must meet both Benchmarks on SAT Section Scores:
 - Evidence-Based Reading & Writing 460 (of 800 possible)
 - Mathematics 510(of 800 possible)

- ❖ Mathematics-510




Percentage of students within range to demonstrate college readiness

Student Group Comparison




